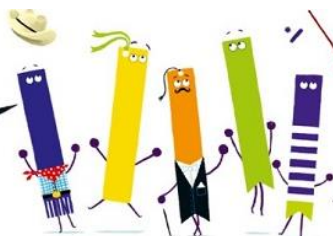

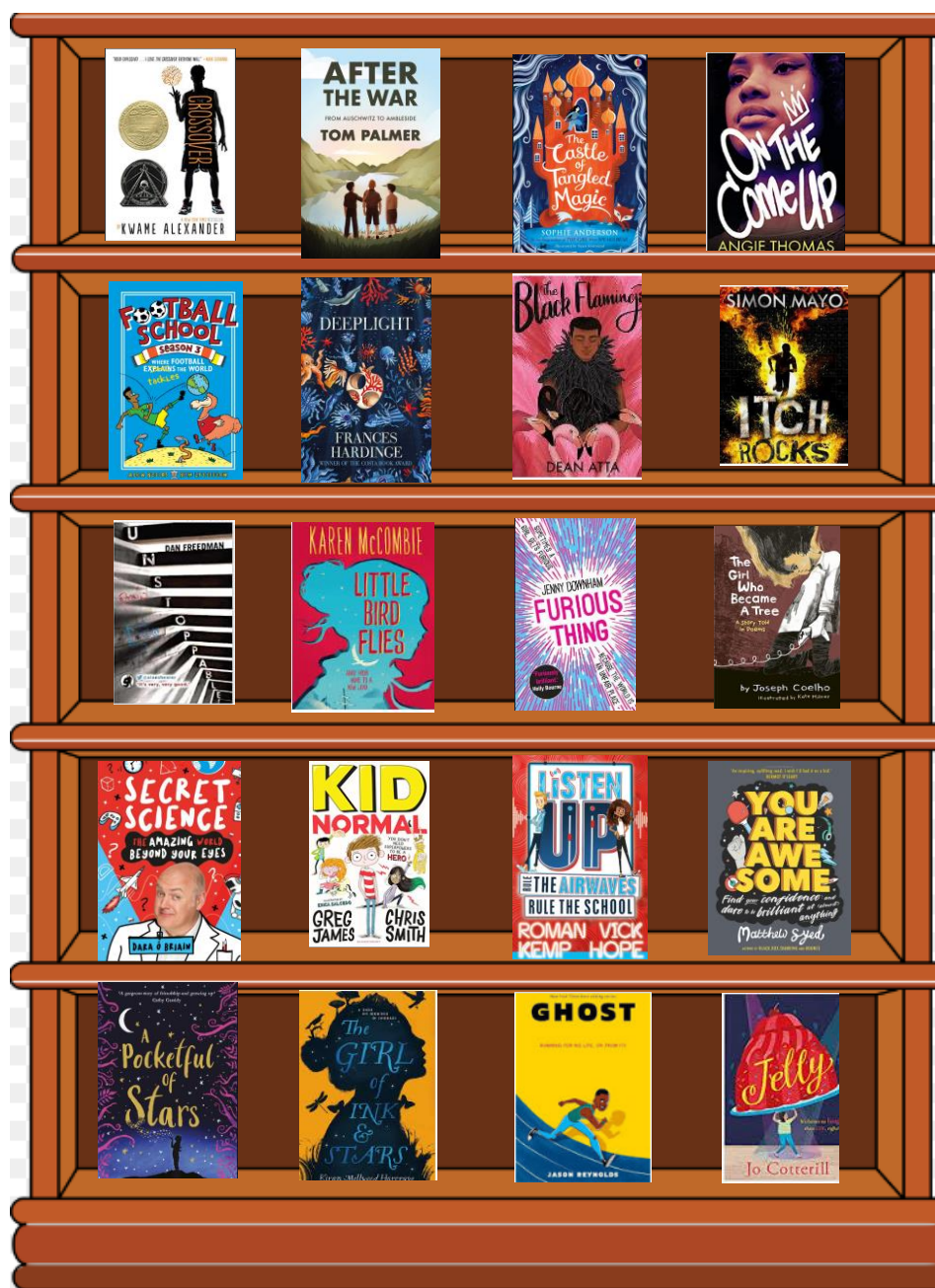

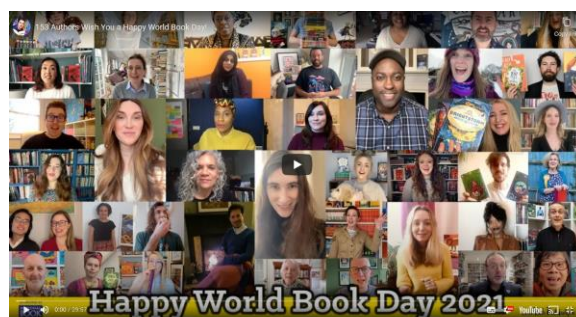


The theme of WBD 2021 is 'SHARE A STORY'.

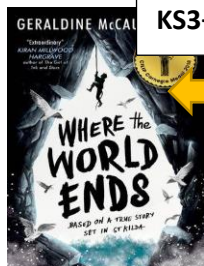
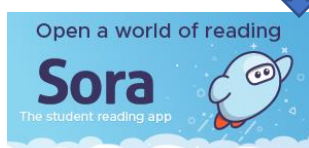
A gripping Victorian murder mystery.

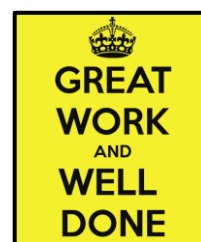
An award-winning story of survival in the harshest place.

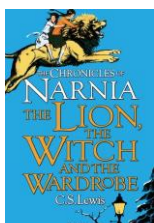
We set KS3 a challenge last week to 'Spruce Up A Spud' for World Book Day.

Well done to Eleanor, Jack, Rameesha and Ryan who wowed us with their creativity. Prizes will be on their way to you when we are back in school!

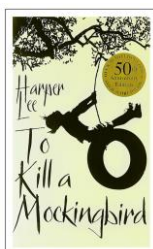

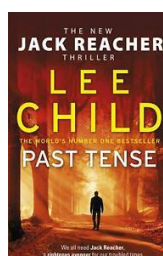
