J.K. Rowling gave Harry Potter the same birthday as her. In the books, he was born in 1980 so turns 40 this year!!!

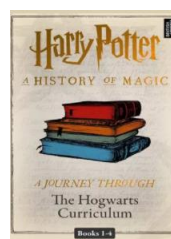
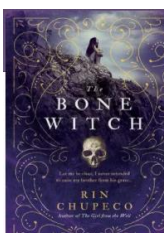

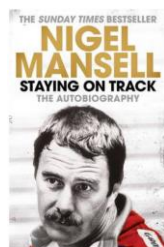
