About the Course:

This qualification is designed for learners who are interested in dance and have some practical experience. The course will appeal to learners who wish to pursue a career in Dance or Performing Arts.

What will it be like?

Students will receive a well-rounded and full introduction to the world of Dance, by developing an understanding of how dance performances are created. They will acquire knowledge that underpins effective use of skills, processes and attitudes in the Performing Arts sector. The course will be tailored to the individual and include both practical and theoretical content.

Areas of study may include:

- Technical skills
- Rehearsal and performance skills
- Responding to stimuli
- Reproducing repertoire
- Personal management and communication
- Roles and responsibilities of professionals
- Choreography skills
- Effective ways of working in performing arts

Beyond Year 11:

This course will prepare students for entry to higher education in a range of subjects. It will benefit students who want to study a vocational qualification at Level 3 in Performing Arts which prepares learners to enter employment or apprenticeships, or to move on to higher education by studying a degree in Performing Arts or Dance.
